

## **Federal Services**

For the agreement between Vendor and GWFS, the terms "Government," "Contracting Officer," and "Contracting Officer's Representative" will refer to "GardaWorld Federal Services" and "GardaWorld Federal Services' Authorized Representative" respectively. The terms "Contractor" and "Contract" will refer to "Provider," "Vendor," and "Agreement" respectively, except for audit rights clauses from the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) where the original FAR definitions for these terms will apply.
